DANCE ATTIRE

Remember to be a dancer, you must dress like one! Make sure that you have all of the dance wear required within the first few weeks of classes as exceptions for improper dress will not be made after September. Black tank style bodysuit is required for all jazz, tap, and ballet classes and hair must be tied up in a bun.

Jazz

- Beige split sole Jazz (no laces are preferable)
- Black tank style bodysuit
- Beige Mondor tights

Tap (All Tap Classes)

- Beige Tap shoes high-heeled Cuban
- Level 1 Tap wear black Tap shoes
- Black tank style bodysuit
- Beige Mondor tights

Ballet

- Pink split sole Ballet slippers
- Black tank style bodysuit
- Level 1 Ballet wear pink bodysuit
- Pink Ballet tights

Modern, Acro and Musical Theater

- Black tank style bodysuit
- Beige Mondor tights, rolled up to mid shin, barefeet
- Black fitted black dance shorts

Lyrical

- Beige split sole Jazz oxfords (no laces are preferable)
- Black tank style bodysuit
- Beige Mondor tights
- Capezio foot undeez
- Black fitted black dance shorts

Hip-Hop

- Fitted tank top or T-shirt
- DWF track suit
- Clean indoor sneakers or Jazz shoes

Hair Requirements

- Hair should be secured in a bun for Ballet, Tap and Jazz
- Hair should be up in a pony tail for Hip-Hop classes

For safety and sanitary reasons, absolutely no outdoor shoes, and non marking runners only in the studio.
